ROBIX ANNOUNCES GRANT OF OPTIONS

October 12, 2016 – Lethbridge, AB: Robix Alternative Fuels, Inc. (“Robix” or the “Corporation”) (RZX:CSE) (Frankfurt:ROX) announced today that the Corporation, subject to regulatory approval, has granted incentive stock options to purchase a total of 1,517,000 common shares, at an exercise price of \$0.22 per common share, to a director and consultants of Robix. The options expire on October 11, 2019, in accordance with the Corporation’s stock option plan. Robix has determined that exemptions from the various requirements of Multilateral Instrument 61-101 are available for the issuance of the options to the director of the Corporation (Formal Valuation - Issuer Not Listed on Specified Markets; Minority Approval - Fair Market Value Not More Than 25% of Market Capitalization).
